Fuel tanks are often vulnerable and fuel can be stolen quickly and silently. Simple measures such as a locking cap, security lighting and fencing can make it much more difficult for the thieves.

Farm gates

There have been a number of thefts of farm gates, particularly in the Broughton area. Although this may not be a 'Neighbourhood Watch' issue specifically, vigilance from everyone will assist in tackling this issue. Also, it suggests that there are people out there looking for metal to sell on so please consider what items you may have that are vulnerable and protect your property as best you can.
