Don't be a victim of vehicle crime!

By following these simple crime prevention measures you can help protect yourself from the cost, stress and inconvenience of vehicle crime –

- **Never leave valuables inside unattended vehicles**
- **Immobilise and alarm your vehicle every time you leave it unattended**
- **Always park in a well-lit street or in a secure car park**
- **At home, leave your vehicle in a locked garage overnight**
- **Never leave your keys in the vehicle, even for a moment. For example, when at petrol stations or when popping back into your house/office**
- **Keep your keys out of view and in a safe place. At home, place them in a drawer away from doors, windows or the letterbox**
- **When leaving your vehicle, check the windows, sunroofs and doors are locked and use deadlocks if fitted**
- **Plan your journeys in advance to avoid stopping in unfamiliar areas**
- **When driving, lock your doors and keep the windows closed**
- **If your vehicle doesn't have an alarm fitted as standard equipment, have an approved alarm professionally fitted to your vehicle.**
- **Protect your expensive wheels and tyres by fitting approved locking wheel nuts/bolts**
